





How to clear the cache in Google Chrome

The fastest way to get rid of the cache data in Google Chrome is the option "Clear Browser cache". You can access this function with the following shortcut:

1. Press the keys [Ctrl], [Shift] and [Del]. Be sure you press all the keys at once.

- 2. Here you will select Browsing history, Download history, Cookies and other site data and Cached Images and Files. Set Time range to All time
- 3. Press Delete data
- 4. Reload your site.

- 1. In the Chrome Settings window, select the Privacy and security tab and then Third-party cookies.
- 2. Select the option for Allow third-party cookies.
