

Prep to year 6 Student Induction Program Expectations



We aim for every student at Capricornia School of Distance Education (CapSDE) to have the best opportunity to succeed in their education within an online learning environment. Through our induction program, we will work with you to build key skills that equip students and home tutors to have a successful start at CapSDE.

What is the CapSDE Student Induction Program?

- The Capricornia School of Distance Education Induction Program consists of 5 guided sessions that all new students **must fully complete** before beginning set timetabled classes.
- During the induction days, students will attend online lessons each day and complete set activities during their offline time during the school day (9am to 3pm).

Induction sessions prepare students to be more confident in the use of the required technology-based skills needed for online. The new student also learns about the key values and expectations of CapSDE.

What is expected of the student during this program?

- The student attends online sessions each day
- The student completes the full induction course
- The student completes the set activities during independent time
- The student seeks assistance at any point when needed

What is expected of the Home Tutor during this program?

- The Home Tutor has set their student up with all requirement equipment and materials
- The Home Tutor will need to attend all sessions alongside their student/s

What happens if they don't complete the program?

If a student misses a session of the induction course, they will be moved into the course for the following week to complete the missed session. A student cannot begin their normal classes until they have completed the induction course.
